


1. HOW TO ACCESS ESK MOODLE


1. Accessing ESK MOODLE


- To visit the ESK Moodle Homepage, please open the following URL in a web browser (preferably Google Chrome or Mozilla FireFox)
 - ESK Moodle Login Page
- You will be asked for your USERNAME and PASSWORD. Your username should look like this:
 - m.peterson (for a user with first name: Mark and Surname: Peterson)
 - Use your current password (the one you already have, hopefully!) and click on Login Button.
 - Once you are logged in, you will be asked to change your password.
 - Make sure you use at least one capital letter, one number and one special character in your password.
 - Make sure you note down your username and password somewhere as backup and keep it private and safe.

Important Notes:

- If you are a <u>new student</u> in ESK secondary, your username and password will be emailed to your/your parent's email account.
- Make sure your computer keyboard is set to ENGLISH. All the letters must be typed using ENGLISH alphabet.
- Keep your login details saved securely.

3. Attending Zoom Sessions on Moodle

- On Moodle, your homeroom or subject teachers will post Zoom sessions to meet with you and run lessons online.
- The following pages will guide you through how to join the Zoom online sessions.

3. Attending Zoom Sessions on Moodle

 According to the newly upgraded Zoom Policies, persons under 16 are not eligible to have an independent Zoom accounts. This is the message you will receive if you attempt to create one:


You are not eligible to sign up for Zoom at this time

- If you are under 16 and already have a Zoom Account:
 - Make sure you sign out from Zoom on all your devices and browsers and delete your account on Zoom. It is solely your responsibility to use Zoom only and only for school purposes. Any external communication other than school Zoom sessions could be tracked and have serious consequences.










3. Creating a Zoom Account


If Zoom IS NOT installed on your device, for the first time you will be directed to this page:




Wait for your device to download the installation file.




When your computer finishes downloading the .exe file, double-click on it to start installation of the application.



Let Zoom install its application on your system. A shortcut icon will appear on your desktop as well.





- Once the installation is complete, Zoom App automatically opens, like the picture on the left.
- Click on Join with Video to go into your Zoom online Live Lesson.

Attention:

According to ESK rules, students must always join the lessons with their Video on and keep their cameras on all through the lesson.

3. Attending Zoom Sessions on Moodle

Once your Zoom App is ready, all you need to do is to click on Zoom sessions that your teachers put up on Moodle Course pages and you'll be directed to your teacher's meeting room. You'll have to wait in the waiting room until your teacher authenticates your username and lets you in.

- IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU ENTER ZOOM SESSIONS WITH YOUR REAL NAME AND SURNAME. OTHERWISE, YOUR TEACHERS WILL NOT ALLOW YOU IN.
- BE IN THE WAITING ROOM A FEW MINUTES BEFORE YOU LESSON STARTS. AUTHENTICATION MIGHT TAKE SEVERAL SECONDS AND SOMETIMES THE MEETINGS MIGHT BE LOCKED BY TEACHERS DUE TO SECURITY MEASURES AND YOU'LL MISS (PART OF) YOUR SESSION.

Please wait, the meeting host will let you in soon.



4. Asking for Help and Support

- Should you have any problems or issues regarding your Moodle account, login process or Zoom sessions and connections, or your email accounts, please do not hesitate to send an email to:

- In the subject line, write your complete name and surname and your form class, and please include a screenshot of the error message that you receive.
- The more details you provide in the email, the faster the support team's effort to resolve the issue.
 This avoids back and forth emails to collect enough data for problem solving.



5. RULES & REGULATIONS

Zoom Class Rules

- 1. Be on time.
- Be in a quiet place, free from distractions like pets, or televisions.
- 3. Be dressed appropriately.
- 4. Sit properly on a chair not in bed.
- 5. Keep your video on and focus on your teacher.
- 6. Be aware of the appropriateness of your profile picture and your background.
- 7. Follow your teacher's instructions on turn-taking and use of the microphone.

- 8. Don't chew gum or eat during your session.
- 9. Don't use the chat box in any way beyond that instructed by your teacher.
- 10. Don't change your username.
- 11. Don't share your zoom meeting links with anyone.
- 12. Remember that this is a classroom, so appropriate and polite behaviour and speech are expected at all times.
- 13. If you miss a lesson, make sure to follow up with your teacher so that you don't fall behind.
- 14. Enjoy your lesson!

5. Rules and Regulations

 At ESK, we have very strict policies for the use of ESK Moodle and Zoom applications for online sessions in order to maintain our professional level of education delivery.

 Breaching any of the points mentioned in the school's policies could result in suspension from ESK Moodle, the blocking of your Zoom account, and other disciplinary measures.

5. Rules and Regulations

- If you are under 16, the Zoom application on your device must only be used for the purpose of attending your online sessions.
- You will not be allowed in the Zoom online lessons if you use any other personal Zoom account other than simply joining the meetings from within your Moodle course page.
 Your Moodle username and password must not, under any circumstances, be shared with anyone.

5. Rules and Regulations

- Sharing the Zoom Meeting links, meeting IDs and passwords with anyone, even your classmates, is strictly prohibited. Sharing the mentioned data with third parties is a violation of Online Safety and Security policies for K-12 Education and universal <u>Children's Online Privacy Protection Act</u>. Sharing meeting details with anyone outside school or even class jeopardises the safety and security of the attendees in the meeting and puts the live lesson sessions at risk. Any sort of recording or screenshotting of meeting sessions or Moodle pages is against the Law of Digital Data Protection.
- Should you have trouble connecting, you must ask your teacher to provide you with the Zoom meeting details or send an email to the support email provided.
